- Provide assistance to removed persons with support and resources to enable their return to work.
- Provide education and training to improve awareness, knowledge and practices.
- Maintain a Drug and Alcohol Procedure that reflects this policy.
- Assess our supplier's and subcontractor's abilities to operate within the same framework.
